

# 3-D mammography saved her life. Now, she can keep saving others.

Thanks to 3-D mammography, breast cancer surgeon Nathalie Johnson is also a breast cancer survivor. Her 3-D mammogram found the cancer her 2-D mammogram missed.

Nearly all women survive breast cancer if it is found early. Screening mammography is the key to early detection, and 3-D reveals even more than 2-D. Also, the accuracy of 3-D results in fewer call-backs for a second scan.

The largest study to date on the effectiveness of 3-D mammography found that 3-D:

- Finds 41 percent more invasive breast cancers
- Finds 29 percent more breast cancers of all types
- Results in 15 percent fewer false alarms
