

Persimmon

Also known as the “sharon fruit,” the persimmon ripens very soft, with beautiful, thick, dark orange skin. Its flesh contains very high levels of sugar, which make it ideal for jams and chutneys. The flavor is somewhat like rich vanilla and dates.

Cherry


North America



Originating in Western Asia, but widely grown in the USA, the color of cherries depends on the variety. They may be black, purple, bright red, pale yellow tinged with red or orange-yellow. Flavors range from sour to sweet.

Kumquat

China



A thumb-sized citrus fruit, kumquat is usually bright orange in color. The edible skin is quite thin. The flesh inside is light orange divided into segments, containing green, pale pips. The flavor is pleasantly sharp and fragrant.
